New Chromebook Policy email dated May 18, 2026

As we continue preparing students for increased independence and responsibility in junior high, we will be transitioning to a **student-owned Chromebook model** over the next two school years. Beginning in the 2026–2027 school year, all rising 6th and 7th grade students will be required to provide their own Chromebook for school use.

Beginning in the 2027–2028 school year, ALL junior high students will be required to have their own device.

This transition allows students to take greater ownership and accountability of their technology use and care of their device.

Minimum recommended specifications for Chromebooks:

- 11.6" display
- Intel N4500 processor or better
- 4GB RAM
- 32GB eMMC storage

Please note:

- Touchscreen and convertible/flip-screen models are not recommended.
- Traditional laptops should not be purchased; students must have a Chromebook.
- We strongly recommend purchasing a protective Chromebook cover/case.
