Frida Kahlo

- Frida Kahlo was a Mexican painter. She was born in 1907 in her parents' home. It was known as *La Casa Azul* (The Blue House).

- As a child, she loved to draw. During her life, she had many Medical problems and injuries that caused her pain. She suffered a lot and was often bedridden.

- She was given paints and a mirror while bed-ridden, so she passed the time drawing self-portraits. Of her 143 paintings, 55 are self-portraits. She was clever and innovative.

- Frida married another well-known Mexican artist, Diego Rivera. He was a muralist. They were unable to have children due to Frida's physical illness, which added to her personal suffering.

- Her artwork is inspired by her life experiences and by traditional Mexican culture. She is easily recognizable in her self-portrait with a colorful array of flowers in her hair.
