Please avoid the following titles as we will read them during the school year as class novel studies: A Long Walk to Water, Roll of Thunder, Hear My Cry, A Place to Hang the Moon (6th); Walk Two Moon, Chasing Lincoln's Killer, The Diary of Anne Frank (Dramatized), The Outsiders, The Old Man and the Sea, Banner in the Sky (7th); The Giver, To Kill a Mockingbird, A Midsummer Night's Dream (8th).
