

School Uniforms

SHS use Land's End www.landsend.com or 1-800-963-4816 and Donnelly's www.donnellysclothing.com or 800-498-0045 for school uniforms. Uniforms may be purchased throughout the school year.

The following information outlines the uniform requirements. It is understood that should the occasion arise, the Principal retains the right to modify these requirements if the general welfare or appearance of a student requires it.

SHS sets standards of dress and grooming consistent with a Catholic elementary school. Parents/guardians with students choosing to attend SHS must agree to comply with uniform requirements specific to age and grade level. Regular uniform checks will be done by a faculty or staff member appointed by the principal. The uniform components listed below offer sufficient variety to allow the student a modest form of self-expression.

Grades 6 through 8 | Boys

- Oxford Shirt (long or short sleeve w/ button-down collar) | white or light blue (top button must be fastened beneath the uniform tie)
- Dri-Fit Polo with SHS logo | gray or maroon allowed until Columbus Day & after April break
- Sweater (V-neck or cardigan) with SHS logo gray or maroon
- ¼ Zip Sweatshirt | gray or maroon
- Fleece Jacket or Vest with SHS logo gray or maroon
- Pants | gray or black
- Shorts | gray or black allowed until Columbus
 Day & after April break
- Ties (mandatory) | maroon or maroon striped
- Belt (mandatory) | solid black; no large buckles, studs, chains, etc.
- Gym T-Shirt or Sweatshirt with SHS logo gray or maroon
- Gym Shorts or Sweatpants | solid gray, solid maroon, or solid black, or SHS licensed apparel

Personal Grooming and Accessories

In addition to uniform requirements, SHS believes that personal grooming and accessories must be in keeping with a learning environment which promotes study and concentration, while minimizing distractions and contributing to their safety on school grounds. If the appropriateness of grooming or attire is questioned, the decision of the Principal will be final.

Personal Grooming

- Hair should be a natural color and styled to avoid obstructing the student's vision.
- Boys' hair must be cut above the collar, above the eyebrows, and around the ears.
- Girls' hair may be short or long but must be above the eyebrows.
- Make-up is not permitted. Teenage skin conditions that necessitate a make-up like treatment must be discussed with the school nurse who will make the appropriate referral

to the principal and teachers.

- Shirts and blouses are to be worn tucked in, except for girls ¾ sleeve oxford.
- Skirts and jumpers must be hemmed no shorter than the top of the knee.

Shoes and Socks

- Inappropriate footwear is not permitted because it compromises a student's safety in halls and on stairs, i.e., clogs, flip-flops, any type of heels, sandals, western boots, and indoor boots are not permitted in school, even on non-uniform days.
- Shoes | Soles, laces, and shoe <u>must be</u> solid black or brown. Sneakers that completely meet these guidelines are acceptable.
- Socks/Tights/Leggings | gray, maroon, black, or white

Uniform Shorts

Uniform and gym shorts are allowed until Columbus Day & after April break.

Gym Attire

- Gym shorts and sweatpants should have no visible brand logos (i.e., Nike or Puma) and must be worn with SHS t-shirts and/or sweatshirts, including Fun Run and SHS spirit apparel (sold by SHS).
- Gym shorts must be no shorter than the student's fingertips when arms are placed to their side and only be worn until Columbus Day and after April break.
- No leggings, footless tights, or yoga pants.
- If Mass is scheduled on a student's gym day, the student must wear regular school uniform. Athletic shoes may be worn with the school uniform.

Mass Attire

- Students must be appropriately dressed in full uniform on Mass days.
- Gym attire and hoodies are not permitted.

Other

- Tasteful jewelry appropriate to Catholic school students is permitted.
- Earrings may be worn by girls but must be studs or similar small earrings; dangling or hoop earrings are not permitted, and earrings may not be worn by boys.
- School appropriate hair accessories are allowed.
- Hoodies and non-SHS sweatshirts/fleeces are not permitted as part of the school day uniform.

Dress Down Guidelines

Please note that additional guidelines may be provided by the school, depending on the occasion for the dress down dav.

- No stretchy-skin-tight or see-through clothing
- No tee shirts with violent or obscene graphics; text and imagery should be
- No spaghetti straps, crop-tops/half-shirts, or tank tops
- No leggings, footless tights, or yoga pants, unless worn under a skirt, dress, or shorts.
- No cut-offs or rips/tears in clothing (no jeans with holes)
- No skirts shorter than the student's fingertips when arms are placed to their side
- No shorts shorter than the student's fingertips when arms are placed to their side; shorts are allowed only when uniform shorts are allowed
- No pajamas or slippers
- Sandals may be worn, but must have backs

We ask for cooperation from parents/guardians in supporting a dress code that is appropriate for our school. Inappropriate attire will result in requiring the student to select appropriate clothing from our on-site uniform closet or parents/guardians being called. The school reserves the right to judge the appropriateness of clothing.
